## Six key elements for sustainable cooperation

- Political will and trust are overarching and of utmost importance;
- 2. Finding consensus about what problems need to be resolved and what objectives should be achieved;
- 3. Knowledge to identify and define possible solutions;







- 4. Transparency in the process of finding consensus about what measures to take
- 5. Political commitment and financial means to implement a common programme of measures
- 6. A legal framework for enforcement
