Question 1:

- *How will the water and wastewater sector develop in Brazil in the next decades?*
 - *The water connections are expected to grow from 49,635,000 in 2013 up to 59,164,000 in 2030;*
 - *The current urban population is 177.0 million and will reach 208.0 million inhabitants in 2030;*
 - *The water and wastewater coverage indexes (%) are expected to be equal reaching 95% in 2030.*

Question 2:

- *Enhancing education and capacity building should be invested in which area of the Brazilian workforce distribution?*
 - *Current status in capacity building focuses on strategic and tactical level;*
 - *Approximately 70% of workforce is at the operational level, the basis of the pyramid;*
 - *The workforce expected growth will go from 221,800 in 2013 up to 250,900 in 2030.*
