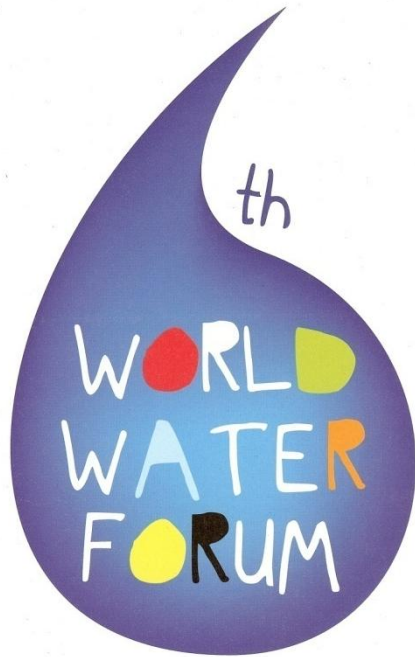

- > **BY 2012**, 50 countries have voted legislative measures to enforce the Right to Water and Sanitation.
