Our aims, in the context of WFD implementation

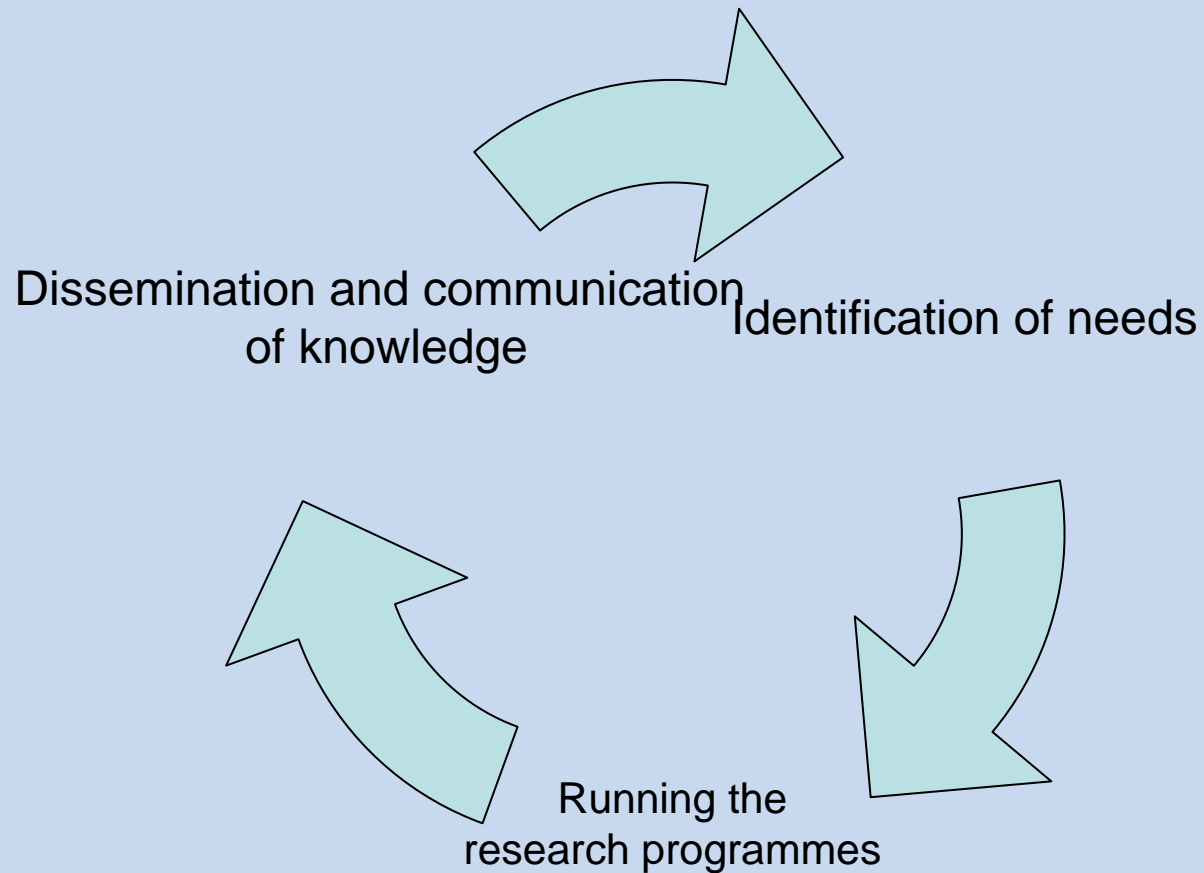
- A forum for prospective and co-ordination of research needs and programmes

The projects





- **ESAWADI**
 - It aims to analyze and provide advice on the potential usefulness of the ecosystem services approach (ESA) to support the implementation of the European Water Framework Directive (WFD) economic requirements.
- **WATER2ADAPT**
 - resilience enhancement and water demand management for climate change adaptation. (Italy, Germany, Spain, Portugal)
- **Water Cap & Trade**
 - Water Market scenarios for Southern Europe: new solutions for dealing with water scarcity and drought risk. (France, Italy, Spain)
- **Climate Change**
 - Impacts of climate change on water resources management – regional strategies and European view. (Germany, France, Italy)
- **IMPACT**
 - Developing an integrated model to predict abiotic habitat conditions and biota of rivers for application in climate change research and water management. (Germany, Portugal, France)
- **ICARUS**
 - IWRM for climate change adaptation in rural social ecosystems Southern Europe (Italy, Portugal, Spain)

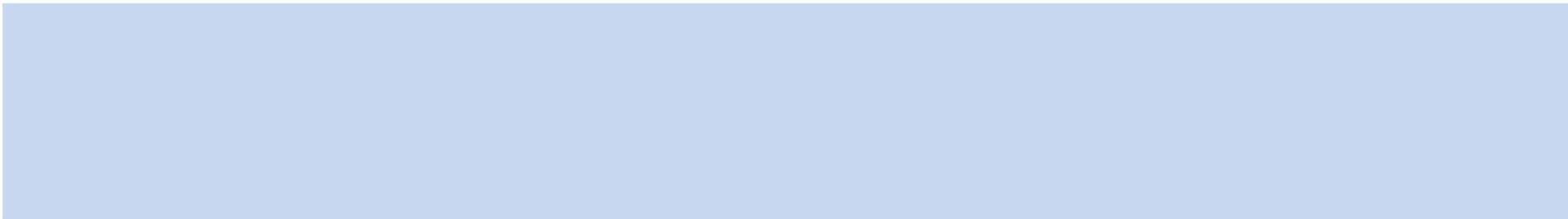
