Session description* (180 words, please kindly use media-friendly language)

Water doesn't know boarders! In Europe there are 69 Transboundary river's basins which cover more than 60% of Europe territory: Their efficient management is therefore strategic European issue. Europe's transboundary water management has been fostered through two very specific instruments: the 1992 UNECE – Helsinki Water Convention and the 2000 European Union Water Framework Directive (EU – WFD), complemented by guidance material and implemented by International River Commissions, in a large majority of the cases.

The EU-WFD require all the 28 Members states, candidates and associated countries to manage their transboundary waters at International Basin District, associating also non EU members riparian countries if the case: These very ambitious tools insure also public participation, economic analysis, transboundary coordination and planning within a common implementation strategy in 3 phases from 2010 until 2027.

Transboundary Basins in Europe are thus required and stimulated to reach good ecological and chemical "statute" of water, and aquatic ecosystems, sustainable water resources management, protection against flooding, prevention of drought's effects and adaptation to climate change. Yet its main objective is a peaceful, coherent, green, sustainable, socio-economic development linking together quality, quantity and ecology. There should not be a one-size-fits-all approach to very different situations and many experiences existing in Europe. Many challenges regarding transboundary water management still persist.

Therefore, the session will examine the experience of 20 years implementation of the Water Convention and of the first Transboundary Basin Management Plans (TBMP) 2010 – 2015 of the EU-WFD and will present which legal instruments and tools, have been successfully developed in Europe to implement those water policy at international scale, to create trust between European countries, to increase peaceful policy integration and implementation with less money and more results?
