The programme of measures: Construction methodology




Two stages: the « good ecological state », then propositions of dispensation that lead to the programme of measures

- Pragmatical approach but some uncertainties left: : efficiency, dimensioning, cost, way to delay dispensations
- Coordination and synthesis: consolidation & harmonization of the 6 local programmes of measures at the basin scale

- Rain water




The programme of measures: results

- Cost of the programme of measures: 9,8 billions € over 6 years










High majority (~80%) around Paris


